WHAT YOUR SPONSORSHIP MAKES POSSIBLE

Cancer isolates. It destabilizes. It overwhelms families. Your sponsorship helps ensure that no one has to carry that alone. Over the next couple of years, our targets are to:

Reach 10,000+ students a year.

Double our school footprint and train teachers to carry the work forward.
Send classroom prevention kits that turn awareness into everyday habits.
Because reducing the risk of cancer becomes personal.

Double our support groups and hire two additional social workers.

A caregiver gets help when they need it most.
A grieving parent joins a group before isolation deepens.
A survivor has somewhere to process fear of recurrence.

Scale Best Medicine, our improv-based program to accommodate 100+ person waitlist.

Laughter becomes therapy.
Connection becomes medicine.

Add two Camp Sparkle staff members to serve more children across Washington.

Reach rural families who often lack access to support.
Launch specialized grief and teen camps, provide travel scholarships and weekend meal kits.
Sometimes stability starts with groceries.

Expand the Teen Writing Contest from 10 winners to 20-30.

Because more winners means more futures supported.

Scale anti-vaping programs by training facilitators in every region.

Build peer-led prevention models.
Because students listen to students.
